

TOWN OF TEMPLE, NEW HAMPSHIRE BOARD OF SELECTMEN JULY 25, 2017 MINUTES OF PUBLIC MEETING

Board members present: Ken Caisse, Gail Cromwell, Bill Ezell
Cromwell stated she would be recording the meeting.
Call to order by Cromwell at 5:30 p.m.

July 18th minutes:

Ezell moved to accept, seconded by Caisse. Motion voted in the affirmative by unanimous vote.

Building Permit for Hastings:

The board approved a building permit application for the addition of solar panels for Honey Hastings.

Discussion of forms and due dates:

Cromwell presented a list of forms the town is responsible for filing, and the due dates. Cromwell also presented a letter from Avatar regarding changes in the way utility poles are assessed. The board will research the impact of this proposed change.

Letter to town board and committees:

Cromwell presented a letter describing the procedure for posting information to the town website and requesting feedback on any changes boards and committees would like to their portions of the website. Letter was approved unanimously and Cromwell will distribute it.

Request for board statement:

Laura Lynch requested that the board state publically its opposition to the current Federal attempt to gather voting records from the state. This was supported by comments from Connie Kieley and Honey Hastings. The board advised that a request to put this on the agenda for the next public meeting should be made.

Motion to enter non-public session:

Cromwell made a motion to enter non-public session under the provisions of RSA 91-A: 3 II(b) and (e), seconded by Caisse. Motion approved by unanimous roll-call vote. The board entered non-public session at 5:54 PM. The board elected to not seal the non-public minutes. The board reviewed legal matters related to the pending ZBA appeal of the Mazza ruling made by the select board, and two candidates for the Municipal Clerk position were interviewed.

Motion to reconvene public session:

Caisse made a motion to reconvene public session, seconded by Cromwell. Motion approved by unanimous roll-call vote. Public session was reconvened at 6:39 PM.

Public comments:

Mary Beth Ayvazion recommended Laura Lynch to the board as a candidate for the Municipal Clerk position. The board agreed to contact Lynch and schedule an interview time.
