Agenda Items:

- <u>Work on creating a Town of Temple Reopening Plan & Signage:</u> The board discussed creating a reopening plan and ultimately decided that due to recent extensions on state restrictions and surges in COVID cases across the country, they will keep the town buildings and outdoor properties closed and will revisit this again at the end of July. They agreed to follow the state guidelines and provide a health screening checklist to be completed by those working or visiting the municipal office, Fire Dept, Highway Dept and Library along with temperature taking. Connie said John will drop off 4 thermometers at the office on Thursday. The board also discussed ordering a dozen signs to notify the public of property closing, safety practices and risks.
- <u>Discuss request for Memorial service for D. Guy</u>: The board discussed this request and ultimately decided that since the Town Hall is closed, they could not approve this request. Caisse said to ask them if they could possibly wait longer, Willard said that maybe they could have their event at the Friendship hall.
- <u>Discuss Jan-Pro cleaning services for the Library and Town Hall:</u> The board discussed the recent 2-phase cleaning at the town offices and if they should have this service done at the Town Hall and Library. The Library did get a deep clean from Dutchmaids cleaning service recently and since the Town Hall has been closed, it was decided to wait until there are clearer plans on when the building will open.
