Reviewed and Approved June 2nd minutes:

Discuss membership to conservation commission

Cathy Joly stated she has been notified that she is officially member of conservation commission now. Discussed Adie Kulis interest in membership (Adie had not yet arrived). Discussed the NH Conservation Commission handbook. Bruce Kanter might have a physical copy but it might be boxed up. *Lincoln Geiger would talk to Bruce Kantner later this week about his NH Con Com handbook.* We discussed the handbook might be available on line. *Sean Radcliffe will look for the NH Con Com handbook on line and distribute to the group.*

Discussed the Regional Conservation Commission group's opposition letter

Sean Radcliffe distributed and discussed the letter and the efforts, purpose of the letter. The group unanimously approved signing the letter. All members signed one copy. Sean Radcliffe would scan the physical letter and return to Bob Dillberger Friday.

Stormwater Management

Cathy Joly distributed two different handbooks from DES concerning stormwater management. The handbooks were made available from her contacts with with Natural Resource Stewardship programs. The group found the handbooks valuable and could be of interest to general public, especially "NH Homeowners Guide to Stormwater Management". The group discussed idea of having series of talks on stormwater management, potentially with DES specialist and possibly with demonstrations in the field. *Cathy Joly will research having possibility of DES resource for a public talk on the topic.*

Barn Tour

Adie Kulis discussed her work with the tour and it's potential to educate and present farming practices. This is important in light of the heated discussions concerning farm related ordinances in Spring.

Discussion of the Kinder Morgan Pipeline through southern New Hampshire.

Sean discussed the efforts of the Temple ad hoc pipeline advisory committee and the Pipeline scoping meeting in Milford on July 30th. The meeting will be before the next commission meeting. *Lincoln moved to have Sean Radcliffe represent the commission at the scoping meeting in the event TCC representation is needed. Honey seconded and the group voted in favor.*

New Members and next meetings

There was discussion about the terms and allowable number of members to Temple Conservation Commission. It was agreed that Dave Repack and Eric FOley are still full members. Sean Radcliffe will send letter to BOS recommending Adie Kulis as an alternate member of TCC. The group discussed possible best meeting nights to accommodate other personal schedules. The next two meetings will be on the third Tuesday of August and September. Sean will send update to BOS concerning this schedule change.
