### **DES Managing Stormwater presentation on Thursday April 21st at 6:00 PM**

The commission discussed the planned NH DES presentation for Managing Stormwater presentation on April 21st at 6:00 PM. Jay Aube will talk on Shoreland Protection / Stormwater Management. Shane Csiki will talk on stream crossings and culverts. Cathy Joly called and invited local town boards and the road crew personnel. *John Kieley will supply a projector in the big room of town hall. John Kieley and Lincoln Geiger will forward the flyer Cathy made to Allan Pickman and the Temple Planning Board. Cathy Joly will distribute a few more copies.*

### **Town owned lots for sale on Rt 45**

The Temple Board of Selectmen want to sell the town owned lots on west side of Rt 45 adjacent the former "MA center". Lot 2-75-1 offers access to trails on Kieley land leading to Pratt (conserved) land and eventually the Wapack trail. The group agreed that having a separate, narrow lot (10 feet wide) from Lot 2-75-1 for purpose of access to the trails is the best choice. There is a possibility the remaining area on Lot 2-75-1 may be non-conformant (too small). Lincoln proposed marking up a map of the lot for presentation to BOS and planning board. *Lincoln will talk to BOS about the idea of having a separate lot and afterwards, contact planning board. John Kieley will send hard copy of maps of the lots to Lincoln Geiger.* Lincoln believes the BOS is not moving fast on selling the lots.

### **Good Roads Day**

General Miller road needs cleaning on Good Roads day. Sean Radcliffe said he would be able to handle cleaning the road. John Kieley would be able to assist but not Saturday. Cathy Joly said should would be able to clean up the east end of General Miller after Monday.

### **Kinder-Morgan Pipeline**

Sean Radcliffe shared the Emery & Garrett Groundwater Investigation proposal (from Temple Ad Hoc Pipeline Advisory Committee TAPAC). TAPAC is suggesting TCC take the task of water testing. Honey Hastings pointed out the first two tasks are more important to perform. Cathy Joly and Lincoln Geiger pointed out that the existing wetlands/water study conducted by Chris Covell should reduce the cost of any new water study. John Kieley stated Kinder Morgan agreed to test wells within 250 feet of the the pipeline. John Kieley pointed out the water used and released as a result of the Kinder Morgan hydrostatic testing is itself a risk to our water supplies. Lincoln said the Chris Covell water study was paid for by funds from the conservation fund. There was discussion of potential restrictions to using funds from conservation fund. Given Chris Covell's familiarity with Temple surface water and aquifers, John Kieley suggested asking Chris Covell to suggest what we should test to establish a baseline water study. *Lincoln will attempt to contact Chris Covell. Sean Radcliffe will distribute electronic copies of the Emery & Garrett for the commission. Lincoln will attempt to get map from Chris Covell study from Betsey. John Kieley will contact Pete Caswell given his knowledge of Temple wells.*

### **Wendy Davis land**

John has not yet contacted the Wendy Davis lawyer.

### **White Ledges access**

No action taken yet.
