<u>Appointment – George Stolz:</u> Discussion about a draft document written by Stolz proposing general conditions for heavy construction projects. The plan is to present a final version at a public hearing in October, which would then be voted on by the Planning Board for acceptance as a town regulation. Stolz was thanked for contributing his time and knowledge.
