MINUTES OF PUBLIC MEETING

Call to order by Willard at 5:30 p.m.

Cromwell stated that she would be recording the meeting.

Old Business: Records Preservation Committee

Town Hall: Ron Pulos, Chair of TTHAC, informed the Board that the annual LCHIP report has been completed by the members of TTHAC. Move by Cromwell to accept the LCHIP report compiled by TTHAC and forward to the State of NH, second Caisse and voted in the affirmative.

Pulos informed the Board that the Trustees of the Trust funds have approved a grant from the Ruth DeQuoy Memorial Fund for framing of the 1966 map donated by Gail Cromwell.
