Hillsborough County Conservation District meeting: Lincoln attended this recent meeting which focused on wetlands protection and preventing the spread of invasive species.

Peterborough Grange ceremony honoring the founders of the Temple-Wilton Community Farm: Honey and Bruce reported on the wonderful, large gathering on November 23rd in recognition of Lincoln Geiger, Trauger Groh, and Anthony Graham for founding and developing the Temple-Wilton Community Farm as the original, continuing model of community supported agriculture. This movement has now grown to some 10,000 CSA's in North America, and has it roots right here in Temple and Wilton.

Review of the year for the 2014 Town Report: Members discussed topics such as the Town Forest, Southwest Regional Planning Commission work, educational issues related to weather and climate changes, and the ongoing need to conserve properties and participate in the TCC work. *Bruce will prepare a draft and email it to members before the next meeting*.

Conservation easements: Members discussed a potential, local easement and steps to pursue this. It was noted that the Society for Protection of NH Forests has been active on a parcel on East Road that adjoins their Heald property.
