

Sample Select Board vote to correct 2010 Warrant Article re Recreation Commission Revolver

Draft Language:

Having learned that the 2010 Warrant Article No. 10 (the "Article"), passed by voters on a voice vote at the March 13, 2010 Town Meeting, incorrectly listed "donations" as one type of money to be received by and accumulated in the Recreation Revolving Fund (the "Revolving Fund") established by that Article pursuant to RSA 35-B:2 II, the Select Board hereby directs the Recreation Commission to neither collect nor accept any "donations" for use by that Revolving Fund.

CAN'T VOTE TO CHANGE WARRANT ARTICLE

Information from Penny Touchette:

9/19: Town has not adopted RSA 31:19 and until done, only the SB can accept donations for the recreation commission.

Will send me language template for adoption of 31:19.

SB established VGC as a town committee and accepted it with the trust fund. NOT VOTER APPROVED.

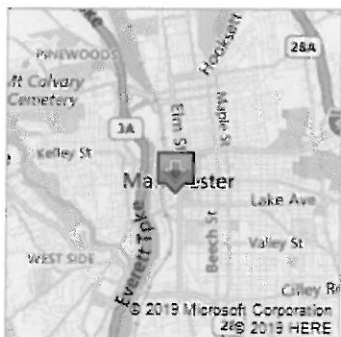

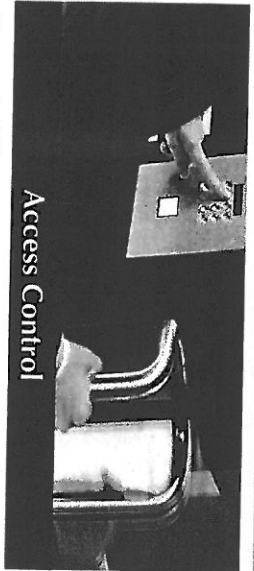
