- 10:30 AM Team gathers at Town Hall. Intro of Team members, review of project/challenge.

- 12:30-1:30 PM Team Lunch – While local community members are welcome to observe, this is team time. Team leaders once again review the project scope, schedule, and expectations for the charrette, public presentation, and final report.

- 6:30-8:00 PM **Second Public Session** – Local residents are invited to share thoughts and ideas with the team at the Town Hall. A virtual/zoom option will be available to maximize accessibility.
- 8:00-8:30 PM Team (and interested community members) debrief
- 8:30 PM Optional gathering at the Birchwood Inn for a nightcap

- 8:00 AM Coffee/breakfast at Town Hall and work session for team to brainstorm and develop their recommendations
- 12:00 PM Team lunch – While local community members are welcome to observe, this is team time.
- 2:30 PM Team wraps up their charrette work and finalizes presentation
- 3:00 PM **Public Presentation** – Team presents what they saw and heard and makes their recommendations. This will be in-person with a virtual/zoom component to maximize accessibility. Attendees are invited to ask questions after the presentation is completed.
